

SPANISH FOR HEALTHCARE, CERTIFICATE

Requirements for an undergraduate certificate may be completed at any campus location offering the specified courses for the certificate.

Program Requirements

To earn an undergraduate certificate in Spanish for Healthcare, a minimum of 12 credits is required.

Non-Course Requirements:

A student may seek this certificate in any degree program or as a non-degree student, as long as they meet the prerequisites. All four courses of the certificate must be completed with a "C" grade or higher. There is no time limit for completing the certificate. Course substitutions are not anticipated, but may be proposed to the certificate head for review. Penn State requires that at least two-thirds (2/3) of the courses be exact to the certificate requirements. At least 2/3 of the credits used to complete a certificate must be earned at Penn State. All students must add the certificate program in LionPATH and must notify the program chair when they have completed the certificate requirements.
