GI 723: Gastrointestinal Pathophysiology and Nutrition

1 Credits

Course provides exposure to foundational sciences and clinical medicine relating to the gastrointestinal tract, pancreas, biliary system, and liver, and nutrition.

Prerequisite: completion of all preceding course work

GI 729: Gastroenterology

5 Credits

Some of the areas studied will be: smooth muscle physiology; peristalsis and sphincter function; neuro-homonal control of motility; psychophysiological interaction in the gut; and symptoms of altered GI motility.

Prerequisite: successful completion of MS Year I
