ABA 457: Understanding Communication: Verbal Behavior

3 Credits

This course focuses on the behavioral processes in the development of language and communication. Topics include the acquisition and development of listener, speaker, reader, and writer behaviors; the application of theory to instructional practices and treatment; and the implications for empirical research.

Prerequisite: PSYCH 100 Introductory Psychology

ABA 494: Research Projects in Behavior Analysis

1-12 Credits/Maximum of 12

Supervised student activities on behavioral research projects identified on an individual or small-group basis.

ABA 495: Internship in Behavior Analysis

3-18 Credits/Maximum of 18

Supervised off-campus, non-group instruction including behavioral field experiences, practice, or internship. Requirements and assessment will include skills including but not limited to national certification requirements.
